Terms and Conditions

By entering the “The Amazing Race Australia v New Zealand – John West Competition” (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. STANDARD TERMS

1.1 Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Australia 18 years of age or older in Australia where the Channel Seven and its affiliated networks (“Affiliates”) signals are received.

2.2 Employees and their immediate families of the Seven Network (Operations) Limited, Simplot Australia Pty Ltd, Hardhat Digital, Mnet Mobile Pty Ltd and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.

3. HOW TO ENTER

3.1 The Competition commences on **Monday 4 August 2014 at 22:00 (AEST)** and concludes on **Monday 13 October 2014 at 22:00 (AEDT)** (“the Competition Period”).

3.2 For entry details, viewers must watch The Amazing Race Australia v New Zealand (“the Program”) on the Seven Network (“the Network”) and Affiliates during the Competition Period. There will be a competition segment aired during the Program which will display information on how to enter.

3.3 In order to enter the Competition, viewers must:

- b) Download the ‘The Amazing Race Australia v New Zealand’ app on their smartphone;
- c) Register within the app to participate providing all mandatory requirements- First Name, Last Name, Email Address, State and Player Name.
- d) Complete a ‘The Amazing Race Australia v New Zealand’ game in the app.

3.4 Entrants are responsible for paying any download charges applicable to the contract they hold with their carrier.

3.5 Limit of one (1) account can be created per eligible device and per person.
