"MINIONS" PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Information on how to enter and the prize form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. The promoter is Yahoo!7 Pty Limited (ABN 60 089 187 100) of Level 2, Pier 8&9, 23 Hickson Road, Millers Point, NSW 2000 ("Promoter").
- 3. The sponsor is Universal Pictures (Australasia) Pty Ltd (ABN 58 087 513 620) of 3 Munn Reserve, Millers Point, NSW 2000 ("**Sponsor**").
- 4. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 21 years or over who are able to attend the Minions exclusive event in Orlando, Florida (USA) on 25/08/2015 and travel on the dates nominated in clause 17, if selected as the winner.

 - h) submit the full completed entry form.
- 8. Incomplete or indecipherable entries will be deemed invalid.
- 9. Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: (a) each entry must be substantially unique; and (b) each entry must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements.
