Illustrative Examples

India - We received a request from an Indian law enforcement agency to block a term from our search results based upon a court order concluding that a website associated with that term contained defamatory content. After careful review of the request and the underlying court order, we did not block the specified term from our search results as requested. However, we did remove the website at issue from our search results for Yahoo India as required by the court order.

United Kingdom - We received a request from a United Kingdom law enforcement agency to remove four Flickr user accounts that allegedly promoted terrorism. We reviewed the accounts and terminated them after verifying that they violated Flickr's Community Guidelines.

United States - We received a request from a United States law enforcement agency to remove message board postings soliciting assistance in physically harming an identified person. We reviewed the posts and removed them and terminated the accounts after verifying that they violated Yahoo's Terms of Service.
